Sweetwater ISD Meal Charge Policy 2019-2020

- Students will receive low balance communication.
- Students will receive communication daily when their meal account has a negative balance.
- The district has a designated grace amount of 3 meals for students with negative balances.
- After exceeding 3 meals of negative charges, students will be provided a turkey croissant sandwich and water as a courtesy until the negative balance has been settled. Payments to satisfy a negative account balance and bring the account up to date may be made at the campus cafeteria or at myschoolbucks.com.
- A la carte purchases will be restricted immediately when a student's meal account becomes negative.
- Unpaid meal account balance must be paid in full by parents/guardians before the last day of school each year. Charging at all campuses will be discontinued three weeks prior to the last day of school.
